<p>God's Message To Me</p> <p>2) Complete the Bible II Award</p>	<p>Complete ALL of the requirements</p> <p>- Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>

<p>God's Power in My Life 3a) Spend a regular quiet time with Jesus to talk with Him and learn about Him. Keep a record showing regularity</p> <p>3b) Ask three people their favourite "Jesus story" (story from the gospels) and why.</p> <p>3c) Complete the Parables of Jesus Award</p>	<p>- Present quiet time commitment cards and any other resources that may have been used. - Talk about what they have learned about prayer/Jesus - Keep a record showing regularity</p> <p>- Record the responses from the three (3) people who were asked the question Complete ALL of the requirements</p> <p>- Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>

Tell each other something that makes them special.</p>
<p>I Can Make Wise Choices 2) Participate in an activity or game about choices</p>	<p>- Explain what choice means and discuss the activity in which you participated - Provide solutions / discuss some of the scenarios they were presented with</p>
<p>I Can Care For My Body 3) Complete the Fitness Fun Adventurer Award</p>	<p>Complete ALL of the requirements - Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>

<p>I Have A Family 1) Ask each member of your family to tell some of their favourite memories</p>	<p>Share by telling stories, drawing, showing pictures and discussing or writing some of their families favourite memories.</p>
<p>Families Care For Each Other 2 a) Show how Jesus can help you deal with disagreements. Use: a. Puppets b. Role playing c. Other</p> <p>2b) Complete the Acts of Kindness Award</p>	<p>- Able to discuss scenarios and demonstrate positive ways of dealing with disagreements. - Share with the assessor about the role play that they did and what they learnt. - Provide any resources that may have been utilised by their counsellor</p> <p>Complete ALL of the requirements - Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>
<p>My Family Helps Me Care For Myself 3) Complete the Road Safety Adventurer Award</p>	<p>Complete ALL of the requirements - Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>

<p>The World Of Friends 1) Complete the Courtesy Adventurer Award</p>	<p>Complete ALL of the requirements - Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</p>

<p>The World Of Other People 2a) Explore your neighbourhood. List things that are good and things you could help make better.</p> <p>2b) From your list, choose ways and spend time making your neighbourhood better</p>	<p><i>- Confirm through pictures or signed evidence by counsellor / parent that they took part in a neighbourhood walk.</i></p> <p><i>- Show the list of things that were good about their neighbourhood</i></p> <p><i>- Show list of things that they can help with to improve their neighbourhood.</i></p> <p><i>- Explain to the assessor the project they participated in either individually or as a group.</i></p> <p><i>- This should be a planned event, pictures showing the sunbeam completing the task is helpful.</i></p> <p><i>- The assessor will enquire why a particular project was chosen and how the sunbeam felt having contributed to improving their neighbourhood.</i></p>
<p>The World Of Nature 3) Complete the Friend of Nature Adventurer Award</p>	<p><i>Complete ALL of the requirements</i></p> <p><i>- Assessor will review random elements of the requirements with the adventurer</i></p>

Bible II Award requirements

1. Own or have use of a Bible.
2. Name the two major parts of the Bible and name the four gospels. Show where the gospels are located in the Bible.
3. Read or listen to three or more of the stories about Jesus found in the gospels. Suggestions include:
 - a. Jesus is born - Luke 2:1-20 & Matthew 2:1-12
 - b. Jesus is baptised - Matthew 3:13-17
 - c. Jesus tells stories (such as Lost sheep, coin, and son in Luke 15)
 - d. Jesus heals people e. Jesus dies and is resurrected
4. Explain two Bible verses about being saved by Jesus such as:
 - a. Matthew 22:37-39
 - b. 1 John 1:9

- c. Isaiah 1:18
- d. Romans 6:23
- e. John 3:16

5. Tell a story about Jesus to a family member or friend. Tell them why Jesus is special to you.
