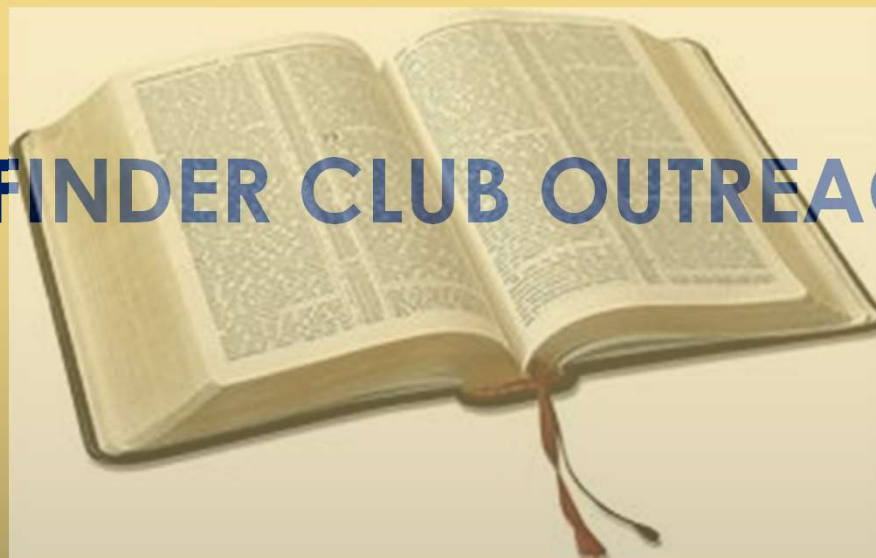

KEY TEXTS

Matthew 25:31-46 – Parable of the Sheep and the Goats

- Sheep commended for their acts of kindness & compassion.
- Goats rebuked for neglecting the needs of others

KEY TAKE AWAYS



COMPASSIONS FOR OTHERS – EMPHASIZE THE IMPORTANCE OF SHOWING KINDNESS AND COMPASSION TO THOSE IN NEED.



PRACTICAL ACTS OF SERVICE – DISCUSS PRACTICAL WAYS THAT CLUB MEMBERS CAN ACTIVELY SERVE OTHERS IN THE CLUB AND THE WIDER COMMUNITY



INCLUSIVITY AND WELCOMING ATTITUDE – HIGHLIGHT THE NEED FOR INCLUSIVITY AND A WELCOMING ATTITUDE TOWARDS EVERYBODY, REGARDLESS OF THEIR CIRCUMSTANCES OR BACKGROUND



AWARENESS OF NEEDS – ENCOURAGE CLUB MEMBERS TO BE AWARE OF THE NEEDS AROUND THEM.



RESPONSIBILITY TO ACT – DISCUSS THE RESPONSIBILITY TO ACT WHEN SOMEONE NEEDS HELP.



REFLECTION AND PERSONAL GROWTH – ENCOURAGE MEMBERS TO THINK ABOUT HOW THEIR ACTIONS ALIGN WITH PRINCIPLES OF COMPASSION AND SERVICE OUTLINED IN THE PASSAGES



INTEGRATION INTO SPIRITUAL GROWTH – CONSIDER HOW ACTS OF KINDNESS AND SERVICE CAN BE AN EXPRESSIONS OF FAITH AND A WAY TO LIVE OUT THE TEACHINGS OF JESUS.



LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT – ENCOURAGE LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT BY EMPOWERING CLUB MEMBERS TO TAKE THE INITIATIVE IN ORGANIZING AND LEADING SERVICE PROJECTS
